

After approximately one mile look out for a right hand turn into Dane Bank Avenue, where you will find the Development.

Close to the centre of the thriving Cheshire town of Crewe, with excellent transport links across the North West and beyond, Redrow's new College Green development is perfectly placed for you and your family. TRANSPORT

Once the home of the rail industry in the UK, Crewe remains at the heart of the rail network, with London just over 90 minutes away, Liverpool and Manchester under 40 minutes and Chester just over 20 minutes. It is also well placed for drivers too, with the M6 close by, as well as the A500 to Newcastle. Stoke and the East Midlands beyond. Nantwich is just 4 miles to the south west, Newcastle and Stoke around 15 miles and Chester just 24 miles.

SHOPPING

Crewe has a number of excellent shopping centres and retail parks, including the Market Shopping Centre and Heritage Retail Park. It is also served by all the leading supermarket chains, with a local Co-op store within easy reach of the development. Just a short drive away, Nantwich is a popular market town, with a wealth of friendly independent stores, while Stoke and Newcastle both offer an extensive choice of high street and independent stores. What's more, the sophisticated shopping of Chester is less than half an hour away

SPORT & LEISURE

Queen's Park Golf Course is just a short distance away from the development, while across Cheshire there are endless excellent courses to choose from. Crewe swimming pool is also close to the development, with a range of fitness facilities as

well as a popular pool. Crewe Alexander provide local football action from the first Division, while nearby Oulton Park offers a range of exciting race meetings on two and four wheels.

OUT & ABOUT

Crewe is home to Phoenix Leisure Park, which hosts a multi-screen Odeon cinema and a bowling Alley, along with the popular Lyceum Theatre. You can also take a step back in time at Crewe Heritage Centre. Wheelock Rail Trail also reflects the town's proud engineering history, with an extensive, safe walking route along the old railway. Alternatively, you can enjoy the fresh air at nearby Queen's Park and Lakemore Country Park.

SCHOOLS & SERVICES

The area is particularly well served for schools, with a choice of primary schools all within walking distance, including Vine Tree Primary, Gainsborough Primary, Kingsgrove and St Mary's Catholic Primary. For secondary education, Kingsgrove High, Sir William Stanier Community School, St Thomas More Catholic High and Ruskin Sports College are all within easy reach.
