


LOCAL AMENITIES

COMING HOME

Whatever you are looking for in traditional village life, you'll find it right here in Beckington. Yet, with the A36 right on your doorstep, and regular trains from nearby Frome or Trowbridge, you'll never feel out of the way or isolated, giving you the very best of both worlds, just like the stunning range of two, three, four and five bedroom Heritage Collection homes we're building here.

Beckington is a proud Somerset village, just outside of Frome, within easy reach of both Bath and Bristol. Mentioned in the Doomsday Book, this historic village still enjoys life at a slower, friendlier pace, creating a strong sense of community and belonging for its thousand or so residents. Enjoy a match at one of the country's oldest surviving cricket clubs, join the whole community, young and old, for the annual Village Day and the hilarious annual Music Hall production, or simply enjoy a friendly drink in one of the fine local hostelries.

LOCATION & TRANSPORT

The A36 is just a few minutes away from the village. Frome lies just 3 miles to the south, with Trowbridge just 6 miles to the north. Further afield, Bath and Bristol are within easy commuting distance and the M4 is only 20 miles away. The nearest rail station is Frome, but for a direct service to London you can travel to Westbury (around 8 miles away). Bristol Airport offers a wide range of flights across the UK and Europe for both business and pleasure.

SHOPPING

The nearby town of Rode, which is just over 1 mile away, has a post office and local shop, however some groceries can be purchased from the nearby local garage and the well-stocked Whiterow Farm Shop. Frome town has Sainsbury's, Asda, M & S and Tesco Express, along with a large number of well know stores and local independents.

For a real shopping trip, head for Southgate Shopping Centre in Bath, or the huge Cabot Circus in Bristol. For an outlet bargain, head for Street, near Glastonbury, for Clarks Village or Shepton Mallet's Kilver Court.


LEISURE

As you would expect, leisure in the village revolves around traditional pastimes including Beckington Tennis Association and Beckington Cricket Club. For a wider choice of sports, head for Frome, where you'll find football and rugby clubs, along with Frome Leisure Centre and Frome Golf Club. Beckington Memorial Hall holds regular social events but for the cinema or theatre you can head to Frome or Trowbridge. When it comes to family days out, you'll be spoiled for choice, with everything from the lions of Longleat to the history of Stonehenge, the caves of Cheddar Gorge and the Roman baths in Bath all within easy reach.

SCHOOLS & SERVICES

Beckington has its own Church of England voluntary controlled first school, providing early years education for most local children. The independent Springmead Preparatory School, also located in the village, offers a private alternative for 3 to 11 year olds. For secondary education older children will naturally have to travel. Beckington children can choose between Somerset, including Selwood School and Frome Community College, or Wiltshire, including the John Gaunt School and St Augustine's Catholic College in Trowbridge.

Private education can be found close by, including Warminster School and at Bath's Prior Park College. The University of Bath and Bath Spa University are both close by, along with Trowbridge College.



Directions

From Bath - Follow signs to A36. At Churchill Bridge roundabout take the 4th exit onto the A36 signposted Warminster, Chippenham. Keep in left-hand lane then continue forward onto the A36 signposted Through Traffic. At North Parade, traffic signals continue forward onto the A36 signposted Through Traffic. At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A36. At traffic signals turn right onto the A36 signposted Warminster. At roundabout take the 3rd exit Signposted Beckington. Turn left onto Bath Road. Arrive on Bath Road.

From Frome - Follow signs to A361. At roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A361 signposted Trowbridge, Bath. At Warminster Road Roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A36 signposted Bath, Bristol. At roundabout take the 1st exit signposted Beckington. Turn left onto Bath Road. Arrive on Bath Road.
